These tomatillos are very large and carried on sturdy plants; have above average shelf life (2-4 wks. in fridge); harvest when paper husks split. Sweet-tart, juicy, crunchy fruit is great for salsa, Mexican recipes. Determinate tomatoes reach a certain height and stop growing. The plant is compact and manageable. Most fruit is borne over 4 to 6 weeks. Indeterminate tomatoes continue to grow and flower throughout the season, so they grow longer vines and need more support. They have less mature fruit at any one time.
